Purpose of the training

- To provide Environmental health officers with the knowledge and tools to better assess and assist in swimming pool regulation. The course will help Environmental Health Officers responsible for the administration *Public & Environmental Health (General) Regulations 2006*

Course Objectives

1. To assist Environmental Health Officers develop competencies for the investigation of swimming pool compliance.
2. To develop and understand correct method of testing swimming pools, spas and waterslides relevant to type of testing equipment and reagents.
3. To understand factors that may affect testing results and other aspects of pool inspection that can impact on compliance.
4. To introduce other agencies involved in the remediation of swimming pool compliance and understand their roles and responsibilities and how EHO's can utilise these services.
5. To present and seek legal comment on the roles and responsibilities of EHO's as they apply to current swimming pool regulations.

Speakers

Amelia Southam – Department of Health – will explain the current regulations and codes relating to swimming pools, where compliance can be applied relating to specific parameters. Where the current legislation needs to be improved.

Warren Thomas – General Manager PALINTEST - Will take us through Palintest pool kits capabilities and correct water testing techniques, Palintest reagents and answer any questions in relation to Palintest products.

Warwick Abbott – Aquatune & Terry Van Heerden - Vendart (LAMOTTE) Will give an insight into test kits, and their abilities. Pool testing will commence with EHO's test kits. Discussion on different types of reagents, storage of reagents and how they affect test results. Provide EHO's with information of different types of kits and their abilities. Vendart will take us through the Lamotte test kit and associated products.

Shane Ince - Certified Pool Operator Trainer (NSPF) / Minda Aquatic Centre Manager will explain basic pool mechanics that apply to Environmental Health officers, Understanding basic pool mechanics what EHO's need to inspect during inspection and how to perform checks on equipment.

- a. Duties of a responsible operator.
- b. Pool environment – parameters that can affect pool testing results.
- c. Pool Maintenance
- d. Troubleshooting for pool operators – Common problems

Cimon Burke – Wallmans Lawyers – will discuss a previous case study and demonstrate to EHO's legal proceedings pertaining to a swimming pool non compliance using current legislation.
